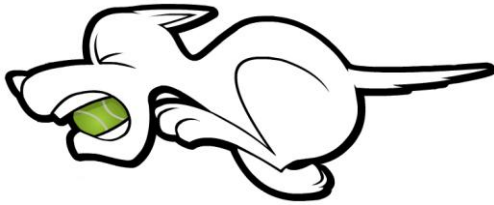

CRATING: The building will be available for setup on Friday afternoon and the building will remain open until the completion of the singles and pairs racing (approximately 7:30 pm). The crating areas are not assigned and while we should have room for everyone, we ask that you only take essential space for your club leaving room for others.

SCORING SATURDAY

Scoring Divisions S1, S2, S3 and S4: 1 point per race won. In the event of no winner after 5 heats, no points will be awarded to either team. Final placement will be determined by adding the round robin points. The highest point total will place 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc.

Scoring Division S5: 1 point per heat won and 1/2 point for tied heats. Final placement will be determined by adding the round robin points. The highest point total will place 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc.

SCORING: SUNDAY

Scoring, All Divisions: 1 point per race won. In the event of no winner after 5 heats, no points will be awarded to either team. Final placement will be determined by adding the round robin points. The highest point total will place 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc

Ties for Final Placement: Two way ties will be decided by the results of the head to head racing. If still tied, the fastest time from the head to head racing will be used. In the event that there is still a tie, the fastest time of the tournament will be used. Three way ties or more will be decided by the fastest time of the tournament.

WORKERS: We will need everyone's help for line and box judges. Please fill the empty chairs to help keep the racing moving. Some lucky volunteers will win a special prize.

RAFFLE: We will have a raffle with drawing on Sunday afternoon. The proceeds will be divided between the Shelby County Humane Society and The Nest project. In addition to purchasing raffle tickets, any donations you may have for The Nest project such as books or toiletries from the hotels will be greatly appreciated. A box will be set up next to the raffle table for donations.
