### **WELCOME TO DOG DAZE OF SUMMER**

We are looking forward to hosting a great weekend of racing starting off Friday night with Singles and Pairs racing. We have 35 teams entered for Saturday and 34 teams for Sunday spread across 7 divisions. Extra copies of the schedules for both days will be available at the tournament desk.

### **FORMAT AND SCORING**

#### **SATURDAY**

**Racing - Division 1, 6, 7** will have double round robin racing 3 of 5.

**Division 2** will run single round robin with 4 of 4 racing and **Divisions 3, 4 & 5** will run a single round robin 3 of 5 racing.

**Scoring Division S1, S3, S4, S5, S6, S7:** 1 point for each race won in the round robin races. In the event of no winner after 5 heats, no points will be awarded to either team. Final placement will be determined by adding the round robin points. The highest point total will place 1st, 2nd 3rd, etc.

**Scoring Division 2:** 1 point per heat won and 1/2 point for tied heats. Final placement will be determined by adding the round robin points. The highest point total will place 1st, 2nd 3rd, etc.

**TIES FOR FINAL PLACEMENT** - Two way ties will be decided by the results of head to head racing. If still tied, the fastest time from the head to head racing will be used. In the event that there is still a tie, the fastest time of the tournament will be used. Three way ties or more will be decided by the fastest time of the tournament

#### **SUNDAY**

**Racing**— all divisions will race 3 of 3 format with the exception of Division 2 which will run 4 of 4.

**SCORING ALL DIVISIONS**— 1 point per heat won and 1/2 point for tied heats. Final placement will be determined by adding the round robin points. The highest point total will place 1st, 2nd 3rd, etc.

**TIES FOR FINAL PLACEMENT** - Two way ties will be decided by the results of head to head racing. If still tied, the fastest time from the head to head racing will be used. In the event that there is still a tie, the fastest time of the tournament will be used. Three way ties or more will be decided by the fastest time of the tournament.
