



Welcome to our 7th Annual Cool Runnings Tournament

Florence, South Carolina February 18 & 19, 2012

We have provided each team with 39-40 heats for a total of 135 races (77 Saturday/58 Sunday).

Racing Format

All divisions are racing a Round Robin format and will earn one point for each heat won, and two tournament points for winning the race. No points will be given for tied heats and extra heats will not be run if the race is tied. One point will be given for tied races.

Friday Night Racing

We will host Friday night racing from 5:00PM-8:00PM. You may either rent the mats for \$5 for 5 minutes, or may choose to race alone or with another dog, \$5 for 5 heats. There will be a sign-up sheet at the site. EJS will be operational during Friday night racing.

 Height dog measuring starts at 7:15am
 Captains' meeting at 7:45am
 Racing starts at 8am

Sunday Schedule: Building opens at 7:30am
 Racing starts at 8am
 Raffle prizes will be drawn at 2pm; racing will not stop for the raffle drawing.

Warm-up times will be at 90 seconds and go down to one minute after each team has had the opportunity to race once.

Venue Information

The Eastern Carolina Agricultural Fairgrounds will be open while we set up from 3:00PM to 8:00PM on Friday; you may drop off your flyball boxes and set up crating areas. If you prefer to arrive at the site from I-95, take exit #170 toward Francis Marion University. Turn left on Hwy 76/301/501/Palmetto St. (beside the Flea Market) and the site will be on your right just over a mile past FMU (Francis Marion University.) Turn right onto MP Nolan Rd, across from the "Economy Inn."
