

GOLD COAST DOG CLUB - INTRODUCTION TO FLYBALL

Flyball is a relay race between two teams of four dogs, running side by side over a course 51 feet in length. Each dog must run down the course, jumping over four jumps spaced 10 feet apart, trigger a Flyball box which releases a tennis ball, then retrieve it back over the four jumps. As each dog returns over the finish line, the next dog is released. The first team to have all four dogs finish the course, without error, wins the race. Any size, shape or breed of dog can participate in Flyball, including mixed breeds.
